

Day Center Services of shuttle, laundry, showers and meals to the

families who have come to us for assistance.





- Coffee Hour will resume April 24th.



Jesus said, "Peace be with you!" Thomas didn't believe Jesus was alive again until he touched the nail holes in Jesus' hands. Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me?
