#### Palm Sunday

Today we follow Christ from triumphal entry to the cross, each waypoint of the journey marked by Jesus' compassion for those who would betray, mock, accuse, or do violence to him. Though persecuted and beaten, Jesus the Son of God is not disgraced; instead, he asks forgiveness for those who put him to death. We have walked the Lenten pathway these forty days, each of us invited through baptism to "let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus." We enter this holy week accompanying Jesus to the cross with both grief and thanksgiving in our hearts, trusting in God's redeeming love.

Thank you for your generous gift of hygiene kits and toiletries to support in helping us assist homeless children and their families. Your donations will help Family Promise of Great Falls continue our mission of providing many essential needs for homeless children and their families. Our program is only successful with the help of churches and church members like yours who clearly believe in our work.

So that you stay up to date on what we're doing, we just completed our 2021 Annual Report which I have enclosed. In a few days, we will open Promise Place shelter that will provide a place for two families to stay until they are able to find permanent housing. We are actively seeking volunteers willing to be at the Day Center from 10 AM to 4 PM during the weekdays to drive the shuttle van, supervise families doing their laundry and taking showers, and to help parents navigate on-line applications for housing, jobs, daycare, and social services. Also, we need volunteers who would be willing to provide meals to the families staying at Promise Place Shelter.

Family Promise has always been a community response to family homelessness involving a partnership of board, staff, and volunteers from the faith community. 
The day our Lord Christ lay in grave
