


BETHEL NOTES

As I Abide in you." – Jesus, The True Vine

"Abide" is an English translation of a Greek word which the gospel writer, John, used repeatedly in his gospel. This word is a relational word, one which has the connotation of trust, relaxing into someone's care, and of sharing life.

Jesus shared the agricultural metaphor of vine dressing, vines and branches with his disciples during his long farewell address. He was preparing them for his departure and the on-going nature of the relationship that they will have with him, with each other and with the world. As Jesus abided in them, they in turn were to abide, relax into Jesus' care so that they would bear the fruit of faith and love in the world. It was what a branch would do in its relationship with a vine. The image which I have included is of a branch which is grafted into it's life source ~ the vine. The disciples would need to trust each other and in so doing, they would trust in Jesus.

This Sunday at Bethel we will share the Affirmation of Baptism. Five of Bethel's eighth graders have completed two years of instruction in the basics of the Christian faith and will affirm the promises of God made in baptism by making public affirmation of the faith and committing to continuing the journey of faith. They are Dylan Erickson (son of Chad & Amber Erickson), Joseph Frick (son of Aaron & Kopper Frick), Madeline Hamma (daughter of Jason & Tammy Hamma), Lauren Lindseth (daughter of Jason & Kelly Lindseth) and Ava Olson (daughter of Tim & Beth Olson). We, the people of God, will



affirm, along with them, the faith into which we were also baptized. We need Jesus and we need each other in order to experience the life God offers us in abundance.

Please keep these young adults in your prayers, asking that God will continue to sustain them in their journey of faith ~ abiding in Jesus' life and love. May we continue to encourage, mentor and teach one another as disciples of the one who is our True Vine, source of life. Come, join in worship this Sunday and learn of how our assigned lectionary readings speak to our relationship with God, one another, and the world which Jesus has called us to love and serve.
