


BETHEL NOTES

Fourth Sunday in Lent



The fourth of the Old Testament promises providing a baptismal lens this Lent is the promise God makes to Moses: those who look on the bronze serpent will live. In today's gospel Jesus says he will be lifted up on the cross like the serpent, so that those who look to him in faith will live. When we receive the sign of the cross in baptism, that cross becomes the sign we can look to in faith, for healing, for restored relationship to God, for hope when we are dying.

Blackfeet Nourish has been providing food for the Medicine Bear Shelter and Blackfeet Food Bank for more than 6 years.

The month of February has been grueling. Blackfeet has been hit by blizzard after blizzard with hurricane-force winds. Many people around Blackfeet Nation are both trapped in their homes and trapped out of their homes, in shelters and other people's homes.

100% of donations will go to food for the Blackfeet Nation and dispersed be the shelter and as directed by Blackfeet Tribe's Incident Command Center.
