
Book Study/ Discussion on the Life of the Apostle Paul






Patrick, bishop, missionary to Ireland, died 461 A native of Britain, Patrick was kidnapped by pirates at age sixteen and sold into slavery in

We kick off the Mid-Week Lenten Suppers with a faith story from our Council President Doug Sexe.

Doug grew up in the Riverview area of Great Falls. His earliest memories of church were going to Sunday School at Redeemer Lutheran Church. His family attended Redeemer as he went to Skyline Elementary, North Middle School and CMR. He was attending the University of Montana when his father suddenly passed away from a heart attack while camping.

Doug said that is when his relationship with God changed. He and his dad had been very close. Losing his father and friend so suddenly and young he became very angry with God and pushed God away as well as "everyone else who cared about him and loved him."

It was while dating his future wife Sarah and taking an interpersonal communications class at UM that he learned that relationships do not stay static, they get better, they get worse, but you must work on them. He realized that it meant his relationship with God as well, although he was still very angry.

He and Sara married in 1988 and it wasn't until his daughter Allison was born in 1993 that he decided it was time to work on his relationship with God for the sake of his daughter.

Sara and Doug found Bethel and immediately felt at home. They began attending worship services led by Pastor Mark Peterson. They were soon asked to help with the Logos Youth Ministry first by being table parents and eventually leading bible study. He was then asked to be on the council and was met with budget challenges, starting a capital campaign and holding "cottage meetings" with members to ask for money to build the Gathering Place.

He is now on his second "stint" with the council and is truly excited that his daughter Allison (who along with their son Payton were baptized and confirmed at Bethel) and her new husband Dan (married here at Bethel) are beginning their married life together by attending worship and volunteering with the Logos Youth Ministry.

Doug's message was one of stepping out of your comfort zone, building a relationship with God - even if you don't always agree with his plan, and building a relationship with the church community that you see grow and flourish.

We thank Doug for sharing and look forward to next week as we hear a faith story from Greg and Cherie Stordahl.
