The Gift of God's Global Church

"When companions engage one another in authentic relationships, everyone's lives are changed."

I can attest that the above quote is absolutely true for me and for all those whom I met at the Fifth International Consultation of the ELCA Companion Synod Program held last week in Antigua, Guatemala. When we engage with one another in the companion synod program it nurtures and strengthens ministry done within God's global church. While together last week, we deepened relationships with one another, heard passionate presentations and engaged in conversations on the topics of deepening companion relationships, migration, gender justice, and were given time to establish goals for our companion synod/church relationships for the next three years.

While there we also created a tangible symbol (a colorful weaving) reflecting our companion synod/ church relationship. pictured below. On Sunday, we were bused into Guatemala City to worship at a number of different locations with our brothers and sisters of the Augustinian Lutheran Church of Guatemala. (ILAG). The group which Pastor Natalie and I were assigned to, worshipped in a classroom with elementary aged children of the Augustinian Lutheran School. (see picture below)

ELCA Bishop Michael Rinehart was the preacher, and until arriving, anticipated an adult aged worshipping community. He quickly adjusted the proclamation of the gospel so as to speak to the children gathered. Pastor Natalie Faltin sprang from her seat to help lead the singing by offering the sign language for the song, "Jesus Loves Me." Spirit filled worship is indeed spontaneous and joy-filled!

Shortly after my MT. Synod colleague and participant, Pastor Natalie Faltin, and I arrived in Antigua, we were informed that our companion

MT. Synod Bishop Laurie Jungling, ELCA Global/ Regional representative and interpreter, Gustavo Driau, Pastor Natalie and myself. We all agreed that we would persevere with the resources of modern communication, the help of the ELCA Global Mission and the guiding presence of the Holy Spirit to accompany one another in the ministries we do in each of our contexts. In the Fall of 2018, eight of us from the MT. Synod journeyed to Bolivia to help the IELB celebrate eighty years in mission and ministry. We also visited ministry sites and offered the witness of some Lay Pastoral Associates (LPA's), Dave Scholten among them, with the IELB and how valuable the LPA program has been across the MT. Synod. We also will be accompanying the IELB in establishing an LPA program similar to ours in order to serve their ministry needs.

I am grateful for the long term agreement and commitment the MT. Synod has made with the IELB and look forward to the future of this companion/church relationship. I am also grateful for the prayers and the generous financial support which made it possible for me to attend the consultation and represent Bishop Jungling, the MT. Synod. My gratitude to the MT. Synod for their generous support of Pastor Natalie to represent the MT. Synod at this consultation as well. Our faithful and generous Mission Support sustains this shared and vital ministry!

Please join me in including the people of Bolivia in prayer during these turbulent times and in the process of electing new leadership as well as the on going Companion Synod relationship with the IELB.
