

Second Sunday After Epiphany

1 SAMUEL 3:1-10 [11-20]

PSALM 139:1-6, 13-18

JOHN 1:43-51

All the baptized have a calling in God's world. God calls not just pastors and deacons but also the youngest child, like Samuel. The story of the calling of Nathanael plays with the idea of place. Nathanael initially dismisses Jesus because he comes from Nazareth. But where we come from isn't important; it's where—or rather whom—we come to. Jesus refers to Jacob, who had a vision in a place he called "the house of God, and . . . the gate of heaven" (Gen. 28:17). Jesus says he himself is the place where Nathanael will meet God.

BETHEL LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS JANUARY 12, 2021

Bethel Lutheran Church Council met on Tuesday, January 12 by zoom. Here are some highlights from that meeting:

- Pastor Trina led devotions with an opening prayer.
- Colter joined us to discuss the annual meeting and new software. He explained several options
 for running our Annual Meeting during the pandemic and he was extremely helpful! We want to
 thank Colter for his insights.
- Roll clean-up/Church Registry Update Council was very happy to see that the church registry clean-up is going well and we have the number needed for a quorum down to 33 members.
- · Our on-line viewing numbers are high, with Christmas Eve getting 213 families viewing!
- Boy Scouts need to renew their Charter. Council decided to form a committee at our February
 meeting to explore all the options and answer questions to support the Boy Scouts. Without a
 permanent pastor, it is difficult to have someone sign the charter and take on the responsibilities
 that entails.
- Annual meeting January 24, 2021: The health and wellbeing of our members is our main priority.
 Therefore, after weighing the various options, we will hold a zoom meeting, but we will also provide a telephone option.
