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

If you would like to attend in-person worship and would like to utilize childcare, please call or text Tami Grosenick by the Saturday before worship and we will have the childcare open for you.



Pasta e Fagioli Soup

- 2 Tbl. Olive Oil
- 2 medium chopped onions
- 1 lb. hamburger or turkey burger
- 3 cloves minced garlic
- ½ tsp. Oregano and basil
- 1 cup julienne sliced carrots
- 1 cup canned tomatoes, drained
- 3 cans (13 oz) chicken broth
- 1 can (16oz) white cannellini beans or red kidney beans
- ½ lb. short tubular macaroni
- Salt and pepper to taste

Garnish: parsley and fresh grated parmesan cheese

In large saucepan, heat oil and sauté onions and brown hamburger. Drain grease. Return to pan. Add garlic, oregano and basil and carrots; cook for 5 minutes. Add canned tomatoes and simmer 3-4 minutes. Add broth and beans and bring to boil, mashing some of the beans against the side of the pot with a wooden spoon. Reduce heat and simmer 10 minutes.

Add macaroni, salt and pepper, cooking gently util macaroni is al dente. Cover, remove from heat and let sit 5-10 minutes. Garnish with parsley and grated cheese.

1/4 cup water

1/4 cup celery, sliced

1/2 tablespoon chives, chopped

1 can (10.75 oz) Condensed Cream of Chicken Soup

1 can (14.75 oz) Cream Style Corn

1 cup ham, dices

1 tablespoon parsley, chopped

3/4 cup milk (can use half and half for a little creamier soup)

In a covered saucepan, simmer water, celery and chives until celery is tender, about 7 minutes. Stir in soup, milk, corn, and ham. Heat uncovered stirring occasionally, for 10 minutes, top with parsely.

A PATH FOR PRAYER

SOME SIMPLE GUIDANCE WHEN YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT TO PRAY FOR.

1. Become aware of God's presence.

Take several moments to breathe, relax, and invite God to be present with you. Focus on breathing resting in God's presence. Slowly take three seconds to breathe in through your nose, making sure to fill your belly with air . . . and then take three seconds to slowly breathe out through your mouth. Pause, then breathe in again. Repeat that a few times.

2. Review the day with gratitude.

Look back through your day as if you were watching scenes from a movie. What happened? What were you like? What were others doing around you? What are the good things that have happened today? What can you give thanks for?

3. Pay attention to your emotions.

Ask yourself about how you felt at different points during the day. What moments throughout your day have been difficult or tense? When did you feel happy, excited, or at peace?

4. Forgive, and ask for forgiveness.

Who are you angry or frustrated at? Are there things you can forgive and let go in order to have peace? What would you like to be forgiven for?

5. Look toward tomorrow.

How might tomorrow be different? What would you like to ask God to help with?

And all of God's prayerful children say...Amen.
