The third covenant in this year's Lenten readings is the central one of Israel's history: the gift of the law to those God freed from slavery. The commandments begin with the statement that because God alone has freed us from the powers that oppressed us, we are to let nothing else claim first place in our lives. When Jesus throws the merchants out of the temple, he is defending the worship of God alone and rejecting the ways commerce and profitmaking can become our gods. The Ten Commandments are essential to our baptismal call: centered first in God's liberating love, we strive to live out justice and mercy in our communities and the world.



### Chicken, Wild Rice and Mushroom Soup

- 3. 14.5 oz. cans chicken broth
- 1 C. Chopped Carrots
- 1/2 C chopped onion
- 1/2 C. Chopped Celery
- 1/2 C. Uncooked Wild Rice (buy at 2 J's), rinsed and drained
- 1/2 tsp. died Thyme, crushed (if using) or 2 tsp fresh Thyme (if using a)
- 3 C. sliced fresh button mushrooms
- 3 T. butter
- 1/4 C. all purpose flour
- 1/4 tsp Salt
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- 1 C heavy cream
- 2 T. Cooking sherry (optional and I don't use)
- 2 C. chopped cooked chicken or turkey



In a 4 qt. Dutch oven combine 2 cans of the broth, carrots, onion, celery, Wild rice and dried thyme (if using). Bring to boiling; reduce heat. Simmer, covered 40 to 45 minutes or until rice is tender, but still chewy, adding mushrooms and fresh thyme (if using) during last 5 min.

Meanwhile. In medium saucepan melt butter over medium heat. Stir in flour and salt and pepper (if using). Cook and stir until thickened and bubbly. Add remaining 1 can broth. Cook and stir 1 minute more; stir in cream and sherry (if using). Add cream mixture to rice mixture, stirring constantly. Stir in Chicken; heat through

This is a great soup that I have brought to Soup Suppers for the last few years.
