
BETHEL NOTES



Pastor Steve's Easter Reflection Resurrection Life: "Going On Ahead of You."



[The angel said to the women]" Go quickly and tell his disciples, He has been raised from the dead, and **indeed he is going ahead of you** to Galilee; there you will see him. This is my message for you." **Matthew 28: 7**

What does resurrection life look like? If you want to see for yourself, you have to catch up to him...for he is already going on ahead of you. This is the gospel writer's unique description of resurrection life. It would have seemed a much shorter distance for the resurrected Jesus to have returned, first, to Jerusalem and maybe even to have recreated another triumphal entry. But the angel tells the women to go

and let the others know that if you want to see the risen Jesus you have to head north and to catch up to him in Galilee.

Galilee, the dusty out of the way place where their lives first intersected, calls were extended, and life transforming ministry happened. Galilee, the place where Jesus' ministry began and now it appears will begin again. Matthew's take on the resurrection of our Lord Jesus, is that it is something that happens on ahead of us. No longer bound to one specific place and time but on the move and on the loose. It is a power that meets us in the places where we live and work...in the ordinary places of our on the move and everyday lives. Not contained in the church but in the world. The power of God's life which connects with our life. Which brings newness to our lives each and everyday.

The Easter message is that the Risen Jesus is still on the loose, and his power to bring newness is at work in you and on ahead of you, in the world making all things new.

On behalf of myself and the entire Bethel Staff and Council leadership, I wish you and your family a blessed Holy Week.

Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed!
