



Pastor Steve's Message Young Adults in Global Mission



"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I; send me!" Isaiah 6:8

The ELCA Young Adults in Global Mission Program is a

one year journey of international service for young adults ages 21-29. I first learned of the program from a presentation done at a Synod Assembly a number of years ago and, later, was inspired by the number of young adults I met at Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp who, like the prophet Isaiah, were saying, "Here I am; send me (to serve in the YAGM Program)!" This past January, Bethel was blessed to have a team from Emmaus Campus Ministry at the University of Montana, led by Campus Pastor John Lund, come and lead worship and an adult forum. Among the team members was Eamon Ormseth, from Great Falls. Recently, I learned from Eamon that he plans to spend a year of service in the YAGM Program in Jerusalem. In order to make this happen, Eamon has to raise financial support. I learned from the ELCA Global Mission website that it takes approximately \$15,000. per year to support the young adults in the YAGM Program.
