#### **Mission Endowment Committee Report**

The Mission Endowment committee met on November 8, 2021. The purpose of this meeting was to reconvene and decide on next steps forward. Covid interrupted our ability to bring Dr. Jan Zimbleman to Bethel and teach us about church in the 21st century. She is now unavailable to do this training. We applied for a Lead Initiative grant through the ELCA in August 2021 and were disappointed not to receive that. The question for the group was what do we want to spend our money on that is above and beyond mission programs at the church. We have \$2199.46 which is 5% of the total amount in the Mission Endowment fund. Discussion focused on bridging our values and our actions.

#### A. Determine the current issues in our community

- Poll 5-6 people not part of Bethel about issues facing Great Falls (police, firefighter, social worker, etc)
- ii. Poll 5-6 people not members of Bethel about what they know about Bethel and our mission
- iii. Where is Bethel on everyone's radar? Where do we fit in?
- B. Jessie will reach out to synod for assistance in branding or marketing Bethel and our message as well as any assistance in training
  - i. Pastor Jessie is a good face for our message but what is our message? Decide on our message. We then can build a community around this.
- C. Training is IMPERATIVE! This can also be offered as a training to all the churches in the synod. Use the \$\$ to pay for training and marketing.
- D. Ask the youth "what does an inviting church community look like to you and your friends?". Maybe attend events with them.
  - i. Suggestion was to ask our Logos youth (all age groups) what is your perfect church? What would you like to see us do more of? One suggestion might be to take interest in the children's life, not just in church. Possibly attend their ball games or band/choir concerts, etc.
- E. Logos MS and HS are doing very well with many kids. Pre-K to 6th...there are very few. There used to be 10 tables of kids, now we only use 2 tables.
- F. We need to reach out to TLC once we've figured out our "branding". This is a community that is already familiar with part of our church and we have not made a concerted effort to welcome them.


