

New Chairs for the Sanctuary?

The property committee has put many hours into finding the best prices and products for our future chairs in the sanctuary! According to our Constitution, whenever the Council wishes to spend money on things that are not in the budget, and cost above 2% of the annual expenses for the church, there must be a congregational vote. Therefore, the Council is calling a Congregational Meeting on June 11 at 10:45am (or directly following worship) to take a vote approving the purchase of 150 new chairs and the reupholstery of ten chairs. The ten chairs are ones that have arms, and are needed for several members in the congregation, but are not able to be ordered with the rest of the chairs. The total cost of this project is \$11,032.23 (including shipping). We will be having a "Sponsor a Chair" drive to pay for a portion of the chairs, and any remainder will be paid out of the Memorials Account. We need a quorum of at least 32 people there, so please join us in person or on Zoom so that we can make this important decision and move forward!



GOSPEL MESSAGE June 1, 2023, The Holy Trinity Assembly Required

Many of us are dumbfounded by instructions, even if we have the patience to read them. We may in fact ignore them, ripping open a cardboard box holding a new gadget, toy, or piece of furniture and launching into assembly without bothering to find the enclosed paperwork. In this story from Matthew, the instructions for the twelve laborers are clear: cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, and cast out demons. Having watched Jesus' ministry of proclamation and healing, they are sent out on their own ministry to do the same.

Are they ready? Who knows. If we're honest, we seldom feel completely ready for tasks before us, even if we've read or heard the instructions. Instructions only take us so far, after all. Then we're on our own. Or better yet, on a team. That's where our creativity and can-do spirit kick in.

Sounds like the church, doesn't it? In this sending of the disciples, the church is cast into the world with the mission of preaching, teaching, and healing. These verses from Matthew, filled with both compassion and urgency, are for the original audience and for us. Jesus sends us too. And more than "some" assembly is required. We need the entire assembly! We laborers are sent first from the font, then week after week from the table.

The words in the service of Holy Baptism send us into the world to "proclaim Christ through word and deed, care for others and the world God made, and work for justice and peace" (*ELW*, p. 228). Thank God for those who labor with us and cheer us on our way. We need both the instructions and the assembly. And most importantly, the Holy One who sends us out.
