Chapter 5:


I walk down another street.

Road Construction on Fox Farm Road beginning May 31st extending approximately 1 mile from just north of the Alder Drive intersection ending just sound of the East Fiesta intersection.

The scope of work on this area includes cold milling the road, where a thin layer of the existing pavement is removed to create a smooth surface. Once this is complete, the road will be paved and pavement markings will be painted on the new asphalt surface. New road signs will also be installed and select sidewalk ramps will be updated to meet ADA compliance.
